

Getting to the Melbourne Expo



By tram:

There are 2 tram stops outside the Melbourne Convention Centre & 1 stop at the Melbourne Exhibition Centre. Tram No's. 12, 96 & 109 travel along Clarendon Street from South Melbourne, Port Melbourne & St Kilda and service the CBD via Collins & Bourke Streets. No. 70 runs along Flinders Street stopping on the north side of the Melbourne Convention Centre.

Trams run every 6-8 minutes during peak times, 7.00am - 9.00am & 4.00pm - 6.00pm and every 10-12 minutes between 9.00am & 4.00pm. The City Circle Tram service also provides a free and convenient way to get around central Melbourne.

By train:

The Southern Cross Station is just a short stroll from the Melbourne Exhibition & Convention Centre. The Dandenong, Frankston, Belgrave, Lilydale and Sandringham lines run every 15 minutes & St Albans, Williamstown, Werribee, Upfield, Epping and Eltham run every 20 minutes. Take the train to Southern Cross Station. Tram numbers 96, 109 and 112 travel past Southern Cross Station down Spencer/Clarendon Streets and stop opposite the MCEC.



By taxi:

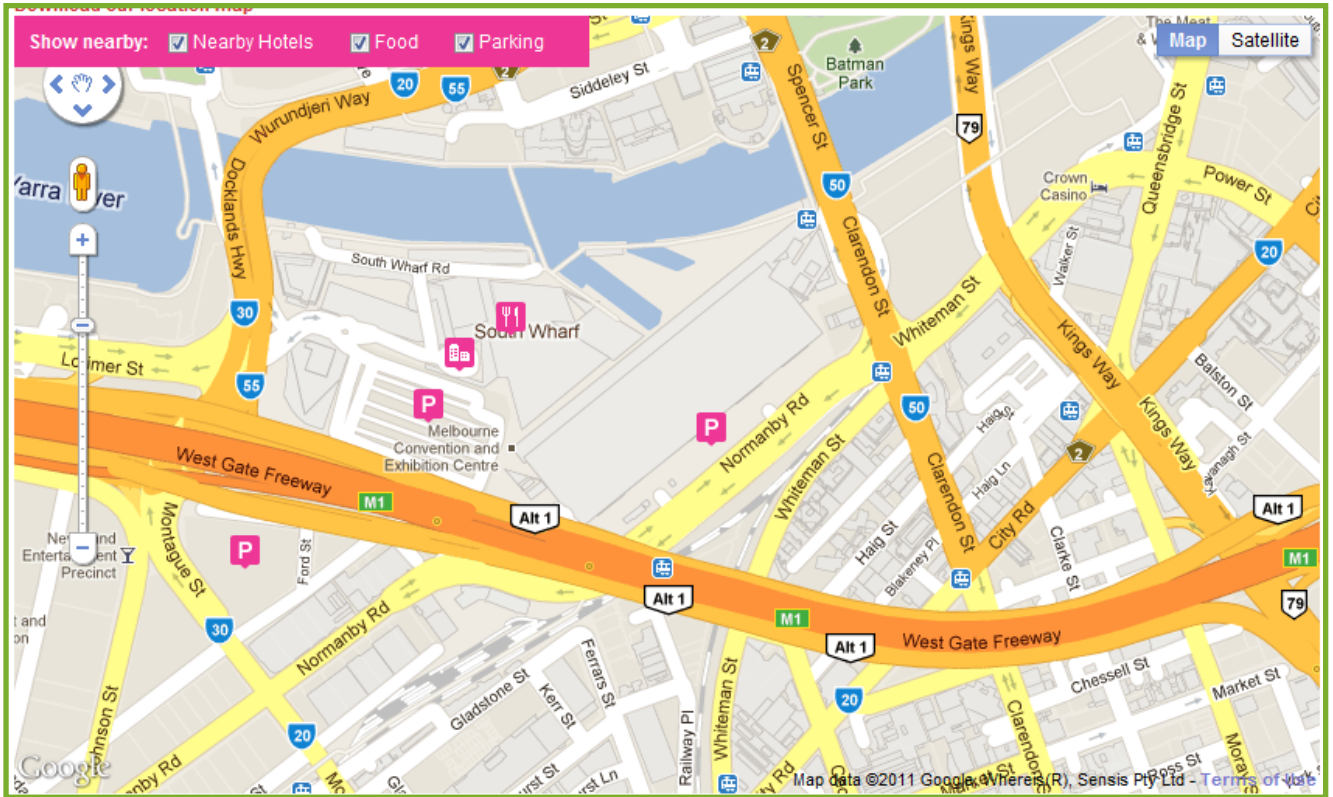
Taxi ranks are located at both the Melbourne Exhibition Centre & the Melbourne Convention Centre as well as all major hotels, Crown Entertainment Complex & Southern Cross and Flinders Street Stations

If arriving by taxi, drop off points are at 1 Convention Centre Place or 2 Clarendon Street, South Wharf.
